ALABAMA COLLEGE, SRICF, INDUCTS TWO

At the winter meeting of Alabama College, Societas Rosicruciana in Civitatibus Foederatis, Two Sir Knights presented themselves for induction. The meeting was held in the hall of Solar Lodge No. 914 in Huntsville and was opened at 9 AM January 16 by Chief Adept George Marshall.
