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**Steps and Marching**

<b>55</b>	All steps and marching executed from a halt, except the right step, begin with the left foot
<b>56</b>	The length of the full step in quick time is 30 inches, measured from heel to heel.
<b>Quick time:</b>	The cadence is at 120 steps per minute (Normal Marching)
<b>Common Time</b>	The cadence is 90 steps per minute with a 30-inch step
<b>Double Time</b>	The length of step is 36 inches and the rate is 180 steps per minute
<b>57</b>	All steps and marching and movements involving march are executed in quick time (120/minute) unless double time or common time is added to the movement
<b>58</b>	The command of execution for all movements while marching is given as either foot strikes the ground, except as otherwise prescribed; the movement commences when the following foot is planted

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Wheels

Par 80 & 187

WHEELING ( Par. 80)
Wheels are of two kinds; on fixed or moving pivots. In all wheels, the guide on the marching flank keeps the pivot constantly in view (Paragraph 18); to this end, the Knight next to him keeps the line of his shoulders a little to the rear, but in the same direction. When platoons or larger subdivisions wheel, a slight uniform bow of the line to the rear is permissible, but any break in the line will be scored.
ADDENDUM ( Par. 80)
In the execution of all wheels, <b>whether on fixed pivots or moving pivots, head and eyes are turned simultaneously with the first step of the wheel. Head and eyes are turned back to the front simultaneously with the first step following the completion of the wheel. When the wheel terminates with a halt, head and eyes are turned simultaneously with the last movement of the halt; that is, as the feet are brought together</b> (Paragraph 67).
<b>Head Movements Following Successive Formulations into Line (Examples: Paragraphs 205, 207, 241, 303 and 304)</b>
In successive formations into line, <b>each element halts and dresses successively upon arriving in line. The Knights of each element complete the halt in unison with head and eyes straight to the front. On the first count after the halt is completed, head and eyes are turned in unison to dress.</b>

In Computing distances, the breadth of a Knight is taken at 22-inches and his depth at 12 inches
This gives 10 inches from breast to back (facing distance) between ranks in column of files,
Columns: Between column of twos 32 inches, Between column of threes 54 inches Between column of sections 120 inches (4 Paces) Between Column of platoons (Class B) =180 inches (6 Paces); (Class) = 240 inched (8 Paces)
The distance of the leading guide from the leading file:  Column of Twos 32 inches Column of Threes 54 inches Column of Sections 54 inches
Commandery distance: Class A = 16 paces Class B – 12 paces Class C = 8 paces Class D = 4 Paces

As the Section nears completion of the wheel the Chief Commands: <i>4. Half step</i> , in time to command: <i>5. March</i> . (on the left foot) one step before the Section completes the wheel. At the command March the Section takes one more step as during the wheel, then advances to the new front in the half step. The Right Guide then moves to his position as leading Guide in the column of sections (Par. 187) and executes the half step conducting the Section to the front.
<b>Rear Section Chiefs:</b>	As each Section nears completion of the display, the Section Chief conforms to the commands as prescribed for the First Section Chief.
<b>Rear Sections:</b>	On Command, conform to the movements as prescribed for the First Section. The Interior Guides and the Left Guide moving to their respective positions in the column of sections as their section completes the wheel.
<b>First Platoon Leader:</b>	As the First Section commences the execution of Column Left, marches by the most convenient route (Par. 26) to his position in a Column of Sections and conforms to the movement of the First Section.

<b>Second Platoon Leader</b>	: As the First Section commences the execution of Column Left, marches forward to the position vacated by the First Platoon Leader and marks time. As the Third Section commences the execution of Column Left, marches by the most convenient route (Par. 26) to his position in a Column of Sections and conforms to the movement of the Third Section.
<b>Captain:</b>	As the Third Section commences the execution of Column Left, vacates his position in the Display and marches to his position by the side of the Leading Guide (Par. 181), then half steps with the Guide. As the Fourth Section completes the Column Left, immediately commands: 5. Forward, 6. March, 7. Guide Left.
Commandery:	Picks up the Full Step in the new direction.
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
