

Tri-Cities Airport (TRI) is a full-service commercial Airport serving Northeast Tennessee, Southwest Virginia, Western North Carolina and Eastern Kentucky. The Airport offers nonstop flights to five hubs (Atlanta, Charlotte, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Orlando Sanford and St. Peter-Clearwater) on Allegiant, American and Delta.

TRI is centrally located between the cities of Bristol, Kingsport and Johnson City, Tennessee, just 3 miles off Interstate 81 at Exit 63. TRI offers both long-term and short-term parking lots located directly across from the terminal building to allow quick access to the building with a minimum walking distance. In addition, inside the terminal area you will find service counters for all the major Car Rental agencies. If you have arraigned for a pick up, there is a cell phone waiting lot for your driver to wait on you.

You can find a restaurant and lounge in the concourse, along with a gift shop. The Airport Service Center is open, and can assist with the following services, access to services for the hearing impaired, copying services, fax services, FedEx and UPS drop location, Notary services and USPS stamps and mail drop location.
