On behalf of the 2019 Hostess Group, I would like to invite you to the 99th Supreme Session of the Social Order of the Beauceant, September 23-27, 2019. The members of the 2019 Hostess Group are working hard to make this an enjoyable week for all who attend.

The Holiday Inn in Tyler, Texas includes the usual room amenities such as iron, ironing board, hair dryer, microwave and refrigerator. The hotel also has free high-speed internet access throughout the hotel. The hotel room rate is \$119.00 plus tax and resort fee, and you may choose a King room with one bed or Queen room with two beds. All reservations must use the reservation code **F20** or SOOB will not get credit for the rooms.

The hotel provides a free shuttle from the Tyler Airport and parking is complimentary at the hotel. See the enclosed sheet with driving directions from Tyler airport and from Dallas Airports. Since our meeting is still a few months away, we suggest that you check on any of car rental services and/or private cab services as soon as you make your airline reservations if you are flying in.

We have a special session planned, please join us for our Tours during the week, Vespers Service on Tuesday evening and formal banquet on Wednesday evening. On Wednesday, we will hold our annual School of Instruction as the Supreme Officers demonstrate the ritual and floor work. 

Fundraising at Supreme Assembly in 2019

The following is a copy of the motions that were made and passed at the Council of Administration on Saturday at the 2015 Supreme Assembly.

Motion #1

Hostess Groups will be allowed to have fundraisers within their 4 years of planning before their Supreme Session, with prior approval of the Supreme Jurisprudence Committee.

Motion #2

Chartered Assemblies will be allowed to rent a table at Supreme Assembly, arrangements to be made through the Hostess Group for the sale of items. The cost of \$25.00 per day (per table) to be paid to Supreme Assembly delivered to the Supreme Recorder prior to Supreme Session. Items being sold may **NOT** be in competition with any items sold by Supreme Assembly. **Prior permission must be granted by the Supreme Jurisprudence Committee of items.** Tables will **not** be open during Wednesday's school, or Thursday or Friday's formal sessions.

(Any state restrictions concerning sales in the location of Supreme Assembly must be cleared prior to reservation of table space.)

The above motions are still active for the 2019 Supreme Session.

More Info: The Holiday Inn Tyler is charging an additional fee of \$20 per table per day for one or two days. If you need a table for more than two days, the fee is a \$50 flat rate per table. Your group is responsible for storage and security of your items. If your Chartered Assembly wants to have a fundraiser at the 2019 Supreme Assembly, below is the process we ask you to follow:

- 1. Read** Motion 1 and 2 and the **More Info** paragraph above carefully.
- 2. Secure approval from Jurisprudence for your Assembly to sell the items you have chosen.** Send the fee due Supreme Assembly to the Supreme Recorder to reserve your table space.
- 3. Complete the form below and send it with your check to the address shown. Deadline: Sept. 1, 2019.**

Tyler Pounds Regional Airport (TYR): Turn East on Highway 64 and travel approximately 6 miles to Loop 323. Turn Right to South Broadway Avenue. Turn Right and go about 1 mile. Hotel entrance is on Right just past Rieck Road.

From the North

Exit 120 at the Tyler Texas Exit. Follow 69 South to Loop 323. Turn right onto Loop 323 and drive approximately 12 miles to South Broadway Avenue. Turn Right again and go 1 mile. Hotel entrance is on right just past Rieck Road.

From the South

Driving from the South follow Highway 69 into Tyler. We are on the West side of South 69 just past Grande Avenue. To access the hotel parking lot, it is easier to turn left at Rieck Road and left again at our sign.

From the East

From the East, turn left at Loop 323 and follow it around to South Broadway. Turn South onto South Broadway, hotel is on right about 1 mile from the intersection of Loop 323 and South Broadway.

From the West

From the West, turn right at Loop 323 in Tyler and follow it around to South Broadway. Turn South onto South Broadway, hotel is on right about 1 mile from the intersection of Loop 323 and South Broadway.
