Greetings Fellow Sir Knights,

Please remember your brothers, cousins, companions, compatriots, nobles and further removed relatives that operate under the many and various banners of other Masonic organizations.

While we all are aiming to the same distant target, we sometimes, quite accidently (or even incidentally) seem to be operating at cross-purposes to each other. While this appears to be the case, it really is just an example that "there is more than one way to skin a cat"; which means our methods may clash, but our intentions and goals are essen-

tially the same: the betterment of man and mankind. Let's try to consider our fellow mason, and indeed all mankind (which, of course means womankind too), whenever we endeavor to proceed on a particular course.

Neither perceive animosity in, nor cause consternation to, our friends and associates who mean well but may appear to be working contrary to our aim. Cooperation is the key, regardless of your mission. Let us continue to improve and make 2024 the best year yet for the Knights Templar and the World.
