# **KTEF GRANT - UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS**

















"A Masonic Charity"

Last month in Austin, the Grand Commander, the Chairman of the Knight Templar Eye Foundation Committee for Texas, and an Aide-de-Camp toured the University of Texas building of ophthalmology studies with Postdoctoral Fellow, Dr. Ashrifa Ali. Dr. Ali was the recipient of a \$90,000 grant to continue her study to find a cure for glaucoma and regeneration of cells.

She is a cell and molecular biologist with a special interest in fluorescent microscopy and bioimage informatics. Her focus is on learning from zebrafish, which can regenerate optical cells after all forms of trauma. Dr. Ali breeds the Zebrafish and has successfully formed four generations. She also performs optical surgery on them and tracks the healing and regeneration of their optical cells. Her goal is to find a way to take this biological concept from zebrafish and be able to use it in people to eventually be able to regenerate human eye cells, ending the slowdetermining disease of glaucoma.


We wish Dr. Ali the best of luck in her data collection and congratulate her on her major accomplishments thus far!

We are growing our challenge more and more, yet we have a steep goal ahead! Our mission is to honor and name 100 Chief Donors by the Grand Conclave.



# A MESSAGE FROM THE EMINENT GRAND PRELATE

### Do you believe?

Easter is a time of great hope and renewal for all Christian Knights. It is a time to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ and the new life that he offers us all. It is a time to reflect on the love and sacrifice that Jesus made for us and to renew our commitment to following Him. In the Gospel of John 11:25-26, Jesus says, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

That is the question each one of us must ask ourselves; Do I believe this? Truly believe this. The Bible, in all our asylums, is open to Matthew Chapter 28. Every Sir Knight has heard Matthew 28:1-7: After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb. There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men. The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. Then go quickly and tell his disciples: He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him. Now I have told you."

At the end of Matthew, Jesus gives the Great Commission to his disciples, who in turn pass it on to each of us. Matthew 28:16-20: Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

The question again Sir Knights; do you believe this, or doubt? Was Jesus crucified, dead, buried, and resurrected? You have to answer in your own heart.

As we celebrate Easter this year, I pray that you will experience the new life that Jesus offers. I pray that you will be filled with his love, joy, and peace. And, I pray that you will be renewed in your commitment to following him. Let us remember the prayer that Jesus prayed for all believers. John 17:20-25: My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one. Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: I in them and you in me. May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me. Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world. Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them. Amen
