Sir Knight Ratliff hails from Winchester Commandery No. 12 in Winchester, Virginia. Serving as our HLP Committee Chairman, Sir Knight Ratliff desires to send out the following correspondence to the membership.

"When I got on the plane, there were other ministers there; we couldn't believe we were going to the Holy Land!" "I couldn't believe I was actually going!" These are the excited quotes from the Christian ministers that YOU sent to the Holy Land.

Christian ministers from all over the United States travel to Israel every year because of the monies you donate for this most special charity of The Knights Templar. Virginia especially values this program. Every year because of your donations from purchasing the **Knight Templar Holy Land Pilgrim Medal**, \$500.00, the **HLP Challenge Coins**, \$20.00, and generous donations from individuals, Commanderies and our interested and benevolent masonic organizations, Virginia Grand Commandery is able to actively participate in this program.

Sir Knights, not only do we actively fund this program ourselves, sending Virginia Ministers, but we rely on you for your recommendations for ministers to send. Being the chairman of this Committee I am regularly asked about how a Knight can recommend a minister.

I always respond, **"Go to the Grand Encampment web site"** The reason is simple. The Information contained there is a complete coverage on not only **"How To"** but it also contains and describes all the requirements, paperwork, information for the Minister, the program in Israel, personal needs and information, as well as the sponsoring Commanderies requirements.

When you do sponsor a minister, remember, this is an expensive proposition. It is paid for from your Holy Land Pilgrimage Fund, and once the arrangements are made; the check is sent; it is non-refundable.

One other thing you should consider, it has been the custom for a very long period that the sponsoring Commandery pay the round trip ticket to New York or Newark for the minister. This has been a courtesy to assist the traveling minister the Commandery is sponsoring.

DEADLINES! July 1 to the Chairman, paperwork must be in, with check, by 1 August, for travel the following February or March! This is absolute! Reviews have to be made for completion, and finance arrangements must be made. This Takes time. If not completed properly, it will be rejected by Grand Encampment.
